DESCRIPTION: *F. lowellii* - Tree to 8 m; quadrangular and winged; leaves 5, rarely 3 or 7, short-stalked, ovate or elliptic-ovate, 5-8 cm long, acute or acuminate, broad-cuneate, remotely and slightly toothed, yellow-green, glabrous or slightly pubescent; fr. oblong-obovate or elliptic-oblong, 2.5-3.5 cm long, usually rounded at apex; body compressed, winged to the base.
